How to take Youth Protection Training

- 1. Go to My.Scouting.org.
- 2. Log in or create an account.
- 3. Click the "Youth Protection Begins With You" logo on the right of the screen. (There's a separate button to take the course in Spanish.)
- 4. You'll see a course called "Mandatory Youth Protection Training."
- 5. Follow the prompts onscreen as you proceed through the three modules: Overview and Policies, Sexual Abuse, and Bullying. After completing all three, you'll be asked to take the YPT Certification Test, which you must pass with a grade of 75% or higher.

How to check your YPT completion date and expiration

- 1. Log in to My.Scouting.org.
- 2. Click "Menu" at the top left.
- 3. Select "My Training."
- At the top of the page, you will see a "My Youth Protection Training" section with your "YPT Status."

If your status is active, thank you! The BSA appreciates your efforts to help keep Scouts safe. On this screen, look for your training expiration date and make a note of it. You might consider adding a calendar alert on your phone to retake the training a week or two (or more) before that deadline.

If your status is not active, please follow the instructions to retake the course.

How to print your YPT certificate

- 1. Log in to My.Scouting.org.
- 2. Click "Menu" at the top left.
- Click "My Training."
- 4. Look for the section labeled "My Youth Protection Training."
- 5. Next to "Retake Course," look for the small blue printer icon. Click that.
- 6. Your browser will open a PDF that you can print or save to your computer.
